Author Chris Winfield writes: "I was in a constant state of "poor me." This all started to change once I began writing a gratitude list every single day for the past 34+ months and it has changed my life profoundly. Here are the 4 most important things I've learned on my gratitude journey:

1. It's Hard at First: My mentor told me to text him three things that I am grateful for *every day*. Sounds pretty easy right? Well, it wasn't. When you've lived most of your life *not* focusing on gratitude, it's not so simple to change that.

2. There Is Always Something to Be Grateful For: No matter what was going on in my life (business problems, I was sick, someone cut me off in traffic) there was *always* something that I could find to be grateful for (my health, my daughter's smile, etc.).

3. Gratitude Grows the More You Use It: My gratitude lists started off very basic and I struggled to find things to be grateful for (especially on the really tough days). But once I consistently took action, it became easier and easier.

4. It Can Help Stop Negative Thought Patterns: According to the Laboratory of Neuro Imaging, the average person has about 70,000 thoughts each day! There's one big problem with this — the vast majority of these thoughts are negative. Gratitude can work to stop these negative thought patterns by replacing it with something positive."

As we begin this New Year, make every effort to be grateful for all of the Lord's blessings. Today in prayer, thank Christ for the blessings He has bestowed on you and seek to be grateful to Him and to others throughout the day.

RULES UPDATE

During a League meet in the fall a situation came up and was brought to the attention of the Rules Committee:

On page 16, rule #6b, the 2024-2025 Rules include an example from Acts 2:17 as an instance in which an interjected phrase should be required as part of a Chapter Analysis Answer. The NLT does not include the interjection as part of the Old Testament Scripture; therefore the example is incorrect. The new text of the rule is as follows:

b. A quizzer must give the interjected phrases found within Complete Answers, Quotation or Quotation Completion Questions, Essence or Essence Completion Questions, and the official Chapter Analysis. (e.g., The Old Testament Scripture in Hebrews 8:10 has the interjection "says the Lord." "But this is the new covenant I will make with the people of Israel on that day, says the Lord." In this example, a quizzer would be required to give the interjection "says the Lord" in the answer.)

UPDATED WRITER TIPS FOR CHAMPION DIVISION

General:

- Quizzers who are deeply familiar with the Scripture and can quote clearly and quickly will do well.
- Patterns will emerge in the Practice DRN sets and official District questions, which will carry on through the rest of the competition, especially in regard to concordance questions.
- The locator in the introductory remarks—whether blind (no location given), from a chapter, or from a section—will typically correlate to the interruption point and the length of the question.
- Most 10-point questions will be comparable to the 10-pointers in league competition but a few will reflect an increased difficulty.
- A variety of concordance question types will be asked–chapter analysis, multiple complete answers, chapters mentioning, verse references, quotation questions, and more.
 - Many concordance questions will ask for multiple complete answers and ask for answers based on similar phrasing or context in the verses.
 - Example: Give 2 complete answers. From 2 separate verses. What happened beforehand?

Districts:

- Difficulty will start to increase at Districts, with some multi-verse 20- and 30-point questions and some concordance questions.
 - Example: Essence question. 2-part answer. From separate verses of Acts chapter 1. Give in essence the verses in which John the Baptist is named.
- About one third of 20- and 30-point questions will be based on the concordance.
- Quizzers will do well if they can quote the material, recite most intra-chapter chapter analysis in 30 seconds, and are familiar with the 2- and 3-part concordance answers.

Regionals:

- The difficulty of the questions will increase a step from Districts. Many twenty-point questions will come from more than one verse, and the majority of 30-point questions will come from 3-4 verses.
- Sets will be slightly more heavily weighted with concordance-based questions than the District sets.

Nationals:

- Approximately one third to one half of all 20- and 30-point questions will be based on the concordance. The mix will vary within each set.
- Twenty-pointers will vary in length, with a few questions requiring a one-verse answer, many requiring 2-3 verses, and a few requiring longer answers or a list.
- Thirty-pointers will be the most difficult questions of the year. Many questions require four or more verses, long lists, or concordance-based answers that would need to be previously studied thoroughly.
- Questions will reflect previous competitions' style with more difficult answers.
